

Welcome to Mount Mitchell Golf and Fish Club on the South Toe River! We hope you enjoy your time on our pristine waters. We have a few guidelines to ensure their preservation for guests for years to come. With your purchase of a fishing pass, you agree to comply with our rules and regulations. Passes can be purchased in the pro shop between 8am and 5pm daily.

DIRECTIONS



After purchasing your permit, you may fish between the chain across the river on the #11 green and the maintenance building on #16. Fishing is NOT allowed above #11 or on the front nine holes of the course. This property is privately owned and fishing there is not included in this permit.

PARKING

Parking is allowed at the clubhouse or maintenance building only. If parking at the Maintenance Building please park on the left side of the parking lot so equipment can still access garage bays. Riverlinks Dr. is a private residential road, cars parked illegally in the cul de sac or along the road may be towed.

RULES

Each angler on the South Toe agrees to abide by the following rules. Wardens patrol our river daily and anyone caught breaking any of these rules will be asked to leave the property. Mount Mitchell Golf Club reserves the right to prosecute anyone poaching, fishing without a permit or breaking any of these rules.

- Must present a valid NC Fishing License on check-in
- Must present your driver's license for information capture
- Fishing permit on provided lanyard must be visible at all times and presented to warden(s) upon request
- Must be over the age of 18 or be with a parent, guardian or approved fishing guide
- Fishing permitted only in approved areas of the river
 - Fishing outside approved areas may result in being trespassed from areas of the river belonging to other land owners. We cannot grant access to lands outside our boundaries.
- Fly fishing only
- Barbless hooks only
- Single hooks only
- Catch and release

LEAVE NO TRACE

Please practice the principles of Leave No Trace while on the river. All trash should be appropriately disposed of following your trip and the river and its inhabitants should be left in the same condition as they were found.

- Plan Ahead & Prepare
- Travel & Camp on Durable Surfaces
- Dispose of Waste Properly
- Leave What You Find
- Respect Wildlife
- Be Considerate of Other Visitors
